## NAMAs: What have we got?

- 90 NAMAs under development and 8 under implementation in 25 countries
  - 40 submitted to UNFCCC (12 preparation; 28 implementation)
  - **Buy-in** for the NAMA concept in host countries: it's the right paradigm.
  - **Enthusiasm** in host countries to design nationally appropriate (win-win ) solutions
  - Willingness and ability of developing countries for **bottom-up action**
  - A community that fosters cross-country **learning** and exchange of good practices
  - Developed country **support** for preparation and implementation
- 'NAMA-support' is becoming a **strong brand** for channeling climate finance



# NAMAs in a post-2020 climate regime

- Needs a convenient unit for action:
    - Flow of climate finance and technical assistance
    - Building block in national LEDS
    - Reporting or commitment to action (UNFCCC either voluntary or binding)
  - NAMA definition is flexible and acceptable, and broad enough.
  - NAMAs are part of the solution, but can co-exist with(in) other instruments
- The NAMA concept has features that are attractive in a post-2020 world



# What is a future for NAMAs?

- **NAMAs can be appropriate:** no need to find a new term in a post-2020 regime
- **Let form follow function:**
  - keep it loosely defined: adjust to preferences of climate finance providers
  - Choose scope that is suitable for mobilizing domestic action
  - Prepare for international (UNFCCC) reporting and possible pledging
- **Please don't politicize the term:** that would take the momentum out of action
- **Keep the good stuff** - it is a UNFCCC success story !
  - Creativity on mitigation in national context
  - Discussions on (co)benefits and priorities
  - Supported NAMAs as one of the vehicles for channeling climate finance
  - Focus on capacity building and alignment to national plans and priorities
  - Learning and awareness raising among domestic actors
  - Cross-country learning and sharing of good practices
